## CHEAT MOUNTAIN RECREATION AREAS



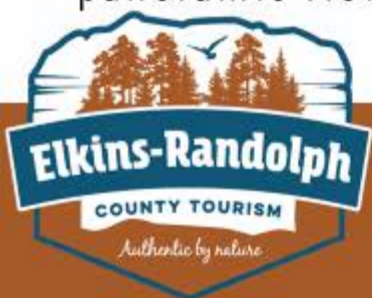
### Directions

**GAUDINEER KNOB & SCENIC AREA:** From Elkins go south on US-250 towards Beverly and Huttonsville. Continue straight for 33 miles on US-250 South. Cross Cheat Bridge and Forest Road 27 will be the next left. A half-mile loop trail leads through old-growth stands of Virgin Red Spruce. The overlook also sits along this trail with a few picnic sites.

**Cheat Summit Fort:** From Elkins go south on US-250 towards Beverly and Huttonsville. Continue straight for 30 miles on US-250 South. Take a right onto White Top Road before the Cheat Bridge then take a right onto Forest Road 245. Along the walking trail are interpretive signs showcasing the site of the battle.

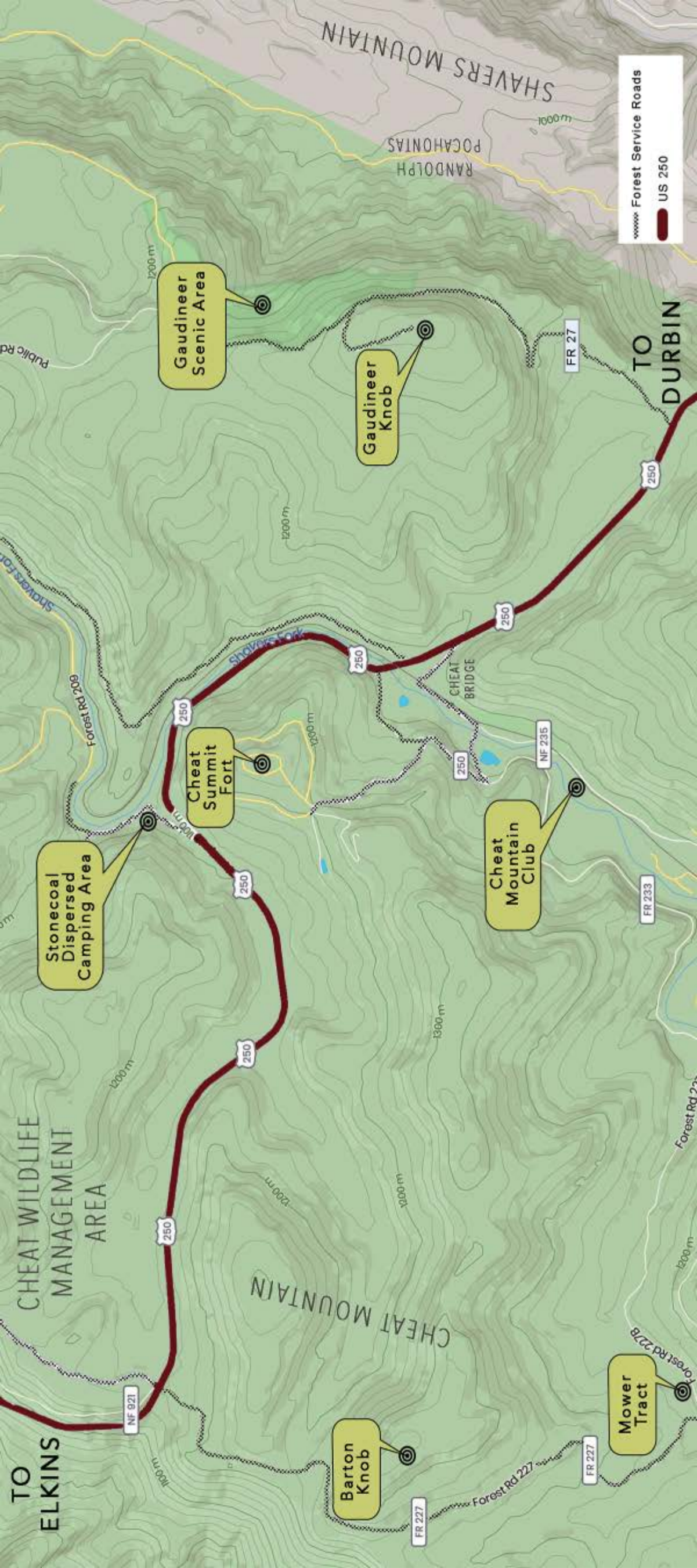
**Stonecoal Dispersed Camping Area:** From Elkins go south on US-250 towards Beverly and Huttonsville. Continue straight for 28.5 miles on US-250 South. Take a left onto Forest Road 209. Several dispersed campsites sit along Shavers Fork of the Cheat River. This area is perfect for fishing, camping, hiking, and picnicking.

**Barton Knob:** From Elkins go south on US-250 towards Beverly and Huttonsville. Continue straight for 28 miles on US-250 South. Take a right onto Forest Road 227. In about 0.5 mile take a slight left onto Barton Knob Tower Rd. Barton Knob offers panoramic views of the valley below and is part of the Mower Tract.
